- The student must be Over 18 yrs of age.
- Grade 12 qualification or equivalent.
- Have an affiliation to the health and beauty industry

CLASSROOM GUIDELINES

- Each location maintains a sanitary manner, including physical cleanliness and aseptic environment.
- Pre-sterilised, single use needles and attachments are used with proper disposal of all "sharp" and "soft" goods. In accordance to OSHA and CDC guidelines USA.
- All products and their ingredients are Imported from reputable International suppliers and approved by the FDA.
- The trainer does not oversee multiple procedures simultaneously during initial instruction of procedures.
- Hot and cold running water on site.

TRAINING GUIDELINES

- We do not instruct on any machinery that cannot be disassembled and sterilized in a satisfactory manner in accordance to OSHA and CDC guidelines USA
- Medical history, client information forms are kept for a minimum of 5 years
- Complete procedure demonstrated by trainer prior to instruction
- Individualized one on one practical sessions
- Each student has individual and fully equipped procedure stations
- Strict procedures of sterilisation adhered to at all times
- Gamma ray sterilized single use sharps
- Products used are disposed of after each client
- PPE supplied by the training facility i.e. The use of protective gloves when necessary

- Files with trainee evaluations, photo's and time sheets are kept for a minimum of 5 years
- Only new sterile needles are used for each procedure.
- Accredited certificates and Diplomas are awarded to all successful trainees. Extra training sessions are available to all trainees until course criteria are successfully met.

The trainer is available for postgraduate support.

1.) FUNDAMENTAL TRAINING COURSE Embroidery Technique/ Manual Technique

This includes the latest techniques such as microblading, 3D Brows, hair strokes, eyebrow reshaping/contouring, natural powdered effect, lash enhancement, eyeliner, and designer eyeliner. Correctional permanent makeup, tattoo removal and much more.

2.) FUNDAMENTAL TRAINING COURSE Rotary Technique

This technique is used to create natural full lip colouring, lip liner, lip contouring, shading, highlighting, colour matching and also corrective permanent makeup.

Paramedical procedures such as scar tissue repair, areola reconstruction, camouflaging related to conditions such as vitiligo.

TRAINING GUIDELINES

- Only new sterile needles are used for each procedure
- We do not train on any device that cannot be disassembled and sterilized or that is disposable.
- Medical history and client information forms are kept for 5 years.
- Complete procedure demonstration by trainee
- Each individual trainer has her own working station.
- The trainer is available for post- graduate support.

A written and practical assessment will be done on the last day of course, after which a number of practical hours have to be completed. If necessary, additional practical sessions can be scheduled at an additional fee, until you feel 100% confident with the procedure.

Please note that clients for the practical days must be supplied by student. (At no additional cost) If you are travel far and can't supply own model, please let us know at least 2 weeks before training course.

Training manual and notes are included.
