

PERMANENT MAKE-UP AFTERCARE – Important!

TAKE NOTE: The procedure is done by a Professional Permanent Make-Up Artist.

After ALL Permanent Make-Up enhancing procedures the colour will be very extreme, dark and vibrant until the healing process is complete. It is normal for areas to lose colour and fade with time. Perfection and durability will be achieved on the Touch-Up procedure.

HEALING:

OUTER healing completes in about 3-6 days for Eyeliner, and 7-10 days for Eyebrows and Lips.

INNER healing completes in 1-2 months.

FINAL healed result is at about 2 months.

A Touch-Up is suggested NOT to be done any sooner than 6-12 weeks after the first procedure. Performing a Touch-Up too early could cause scarring. Some colours (especially Eyebrow colours) take longer to settle in and to see the final result.

EYEBROWS MICROBLADING:

- NO water, cleansers, creams, make-up or any other products on treated area for 10 days.
- For the first day only, 4-5 hours after the procedure, clean the area with sterile water and a cotton pad, gauze or earbud and allow to air dry.
- Eyebrow area must be kept completely dry for the first 24 hours after which you would start applying your ointment 2-3 times a day.
- For the next 3 days blot the area lightly if fluid occurs.
- DO NOT rub, pick or scratch the treated area. Let any scabbing or dry skin naturally exfoliate off. Picking can cause scarring. Do not peel or pick at crust, this could cause pigment loss, scarring, and delayed healing.
- Avoid direct sun exposure or tanning for 3-4 weeks after procedure.
- Avoid heavy sweating for the first 10 days.
- Do not apply topical cosmetics over area while healing.
- Avoid sleeping on your directly on treated area for the first 10 days.
- NO facials, Botox, chemical treatments and microdermabrasion within 4 weeks.
- Apply ointment twice daily, do not over-apply as area needs to be allowed to breathe.

PLEASE NOTE: Eyebrows will appear darker and bolder due to natural scabbing and healing for the first 10 days. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.

EYEBROWS SHADING:

- NO water, cleansers, creams, make-up or any other products on treated area for 10 days.
- DO NOT rub, pick or scratch the treated area. Let any scabbing or dry skin naturally exfoliate off. Picking can cause scarring. Do not peel or pick at crust, this could cause pigment loss, scarring, and delayed healing.
- Avoid direct sun exposure or tanning for 3-4 weeks after procedure.
- Avoid heavy sweating for the first 10 days.
- Do not apply topical cosmetics over area while healing.
- Avoid sleeping on your directly on treated area for the first 10 days.

- NO facials, Botox, chemical treatments and microdermabrasion for 4 weeks.
- Apply ointment 2-3 times per day, do not over-apply as area needs to be allowed to breathe.

PLEASE NOTE: Eyebrows will appear darker and bolder due to natural scabbing and healing for the first 10 days. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.

EYELINER:

- NO water, cleansers, creams, make-up or any other products on treated area for 10 days.
- DO NOT rub, pick or scratch the treated area. Let any scabbing or dry skin naturally exfoliate off. Picking can cause scarring. Do not peel or pick at crust, this could cause pigment loss, scarring, and delayed healing.
- Do not use mascara until outer healing is complete (3-5 days)
- Apply ointment 2-3 times per day with a cotton earbud. Avoid touching area with fingers.
- Eyes may be swollen use an ice bag to relieve the swelling if needed or drinking an Antihistamine will considerably reduce swelling.
- Eyes may feel dry or irritated, a lubricating refresher eye drops may be used.

PLEASE NOTE: Eyeliner will appear darker and bolder due to natural scabbing and healing, allow area to naturally exfoliate. Within 3-5 days' the eyeliner will be finer and lighter. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.

LIPLINER and FULL LIPS:

- NO water, cleansers, creams, makeup or any other products on treated area for 10 days.
- Avoid direct contact with toothpaste and mouthwash as it contains bleaching agents.
- Lips may be swollen use an ice bag to relieve the swelling if needed or drinking an Antihistamine will considerably reduce swelling. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.
- Eat carefully and drink through a straw for first 24 hours.
- Do not apply topical cosmetics over area while healing.
- For the next 3 days blot the area lightly if fluid occurs.
- Continue anti-viral treatment for 5 days if you are prone to fever blisters (herpes simplex).
- During healing process, 5-7 days apply ointment with a cotton earbud when dry.
- When scabbing occurs allow to peel off naturally, do not pick or pull as it will influence colour retention.

PLEASE NOTE: Lip Liner and Full Lips will appear darker and bolder due to bruising under the skin, allow area to naturally exfoliate. Colour will fade up to 60% depending on skin type, within 2 weeks. The final results will only be visible after 2 months. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.
